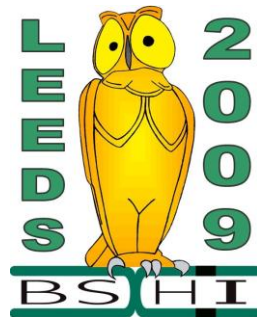

The Royal Armouries is a multi-million pound purpose-built building, which houses a large part of the national collection of arms and armour. There will be opportunities during coffee and lunch breaks to explore the five themed galleries (War, Tournament, Oriental, Self Defence and Hunting) displaying over 8500 objects. Various activities and costumed demonstrations take place throughout the day. In addition there is a museum shop and coffee bar, and the impressive 'Hall of Steel'.
